REMEMBER THE FOUR 'R'S

RECOGNISE
Be aware of the signs of abuse, neglect, or exploitation, such as physical, emotional, or sexual abuse

RESPOND
Keep calm and reassure the individual, if you believe there to be immediate danger, call 999

REPORT
Report the safeguarding concern to your Club Safeguarding Officer as soon as possible or submit your concern to the Bowls England Safeguarding Team via BowlsEngland.com

REFER
The information should be referred to the Bowls England Safeguarding Team immediately, await a prompt response
