Casual Roll-up (Practice): Most clubs are more relaxed for informal practice sessions. While you **must** always wear a change of suitable footwear (Not what you arrive in as this may transfer stones onto the green), 'black or grey trousers / shorts' and a comfortable white top or club shirt are more than acceptable.

Comfortable Footwear: The Golden Rule is you **must** wear flat-soled, heel-less shoes. Absolutely no trainers, sandals, or regular shoes are allowed on the green as their treads and heels will cause damage to the playing surface.

GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION (2018)
